

### **Orthopaedic Symposium Bursary**

#### **PURPOSE**

This award was created to support members of the London Orthopaedic Unit who are continuing their education by attending the Orthopaedic Division's annual Symposium. A maximum of \$1500 is available annually to be awarded to a maximum of five recipients for a minimum of \$300 per successful applicant. If fewer than five applications are received, the individual awards may be more than \$300. In return, the recipient(s) of this award will provide a 5-10 minute talk to LOU members, typically during our annual Speakers Night.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- Applicants must be members of the London Orthopaedic Unit (that is, current Orthopaedic Division members who live within the LOU catchment area which is defined as post codes starting with the letter N)
- Applicants must be registered with the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario and be involved in direct patient care
- Willingness to deliver a 5-15 minute talk related to your educational experience at Symposium to the attendees/membership at the LOU Speakers Night or Annual General Meeting
- First-time applicants will be given priority

## **SELECTION OF CANDIDATE**

Applications must be submitted electronically to the LOU Executive no later than September 1st of each calendar year. Award winners will be notified in September.
